## A few tips to keep in mind to avoid disappointment

### Courses in the catalog

- If you miss more than 30% of the training time (including all sessions), no hours will be credited to you.
- On Amethis, be sure to add the training courses you wish to take to your individual training plan.

### Request for equivalence

- Attending a conference does not count toward the required training hours.
- Whether you are enrolled in a CIFRE program or under joint supervision, unless you submit a request, no exceptions will be made to the 100-hour training requirement.

### Meeting of your Individual Monitoring Committee

- This is a must-do between April and the end of June to ensure your re-enrollment.
- You can also do this at any time if you feel the need.

### Defense

- If you defend your thesis before December 31, you are not required to complete a CSI, but you must submit a progress report on your manuscript and a summary of your training to the site committee at least 12 weeks before your proposed defense date.
- Defense is not possible without :
  - 100 hours of training,
  - ethics training,
  - open science training,
  - and a presentation of your work at the ED SIS seminar.
